

Dharma Night continues -- but with a few changes!

Inspired by Murshid SAM's Zen teacher, Sokei-an Sasaki, Murshid Wali Ali has been giving a weekly Dharma Night class since January that is slated to continue through the end of the year. You can join these inspiring classes as a distant student via high-quality YouTube videos, or livestream once a month via Zoom. Here are details on the options:



- Subscribe to the weekly videotaped classes and join the class via interactive livestreaming the last Monday of every month for \$20 per month. Currently January through March classes are available & the next scheduled live-stream will take place on May 29th at 7:30PM Pacific time. MP3's are available as well.
- Subscribe to 3 months of live streaming (May 29th, June 26th, July 31st) for \$30. Class starts promptly at 7:30PM Pacific time, but everyone is invited for "tea" at 7PM which gives the opportunity to chat with other sangha members. You can ask questions at the end of the class and Murshid typically stops by the computer to see who is joining that evening. The class will be recorded & made available on the Zoom cloud for a few weeks following the class.
- Live stream the Dharma Night class of your choice on the last Monday of the month for \$15 per class.
